

Theatre Code of Conduct

1. One person, one ticket. Each ticket admits one person only.
2. Children under the age of six are not admitted except for a production for children.
3. Dress appropriately. Do not wear T-shirts, tank tops or flip-flops to the theatre.
4. Arrive 30 minutes before the event. Do not enter or exit the auditorium during the performance. Late arrivals should follow the instructions to enter the auditorium.
5. Smoking, eating and drinking is not allowed in the auditorium. Drinks (including water) or food should not be brought into the auditorium.
6. Keep quiet and remain seated after the event begins. Otherwise the event might be disturbed or disrupted.
7. To avoid causing disturbance to the performance and infringing copyright, no photography, filming or audio recording is allowed in the performance hall (including curtain call).
8. Mobile phones or pagers should be switched off.
9. For stage safety considerations, it is not allowed to bring bouquets of flowers from the seating area to the stage. Bouquets should be present via the organizer.
10. In free events, seating is limited and available on a first-come, first-seated basis.
